Organization - Amount Funded

Family Promise of Ouachita - \$33,000

Family Promise of Ouachita is a 30-90 day transitional homeless shelter that targets homeless families with children. The steps vary with each and every family, but the end goal is the same: families that are independent, self-sufficient, healthy, positive, and motivated to be re-established in their own homes. This grant provides for that focus to continue.

Morehouse Community Medical Centers, Inc., Bastrop, LA - \$75,000

This is a one-time grant to a federally qualified health center (FQHC) for assistance in providing the facilities structure and equipment for a new school-based health center (SBHC) at Bastrop High School.

University of Louisiana at Monroe – Department of Dental Hygiene - \$10,890

This grant provides for expenses associated with the operation of the ULM mobile dental hygiene unit (MDHU) as a service provider and a teaching setting. The unit will be located at Riverbend Elementary School in West Monroe, LA, for the fall semester and at various Ouachita Parish schools for the spring semester. Funds are requested for supplies used in the dental hygiene services.

University of Louisiana at Monroe – Kitty DeGree School of Nursing - \$32,000

This grant provides assistance for an educational and supportive program of safe sleep initiatives with under-served young and single mothers in neonatal units and through ongoing services by nursing students and healthcare professionals.
