The Fall 2018 Grant Cycle is now closed. Letters of Intent were accepted through August 31, 2018, with applications thereafter to be completed by September 30, 2018.

The priorities for the grant cycle are:

- Promoting Healthy Lifestyles Through Education, Awareness, and Wellness Services
- Improving Access to Healthcare Through Availability and Affordability
- Addressing Special Healthcare Needs of Infants and Minor Children

The focus for the grant cycle is:

- All ages
- New or expanded programs or services for medical, dental, or behavioral health
- Special emphases to qualified school, hospital, or health clinic settings
- Inclusion of matching funding, a plan for sustainability, and large impact for the region
